• Skill Up - Get £ Powers: An online course to help build your confidence and gain the skills to protect yourself from financial harm. Covers budgeting, financial knowledge, independent living, digital finance skills and debt prioritisation. 8 x 10 minute modules.



• Borrowing and Debt: There may be times when you need to borrow money to be able to afford essentials in the short term. It's really important that you know the basics before you borrow money, so take a moment to make sure you are clued up. 10 minute module.

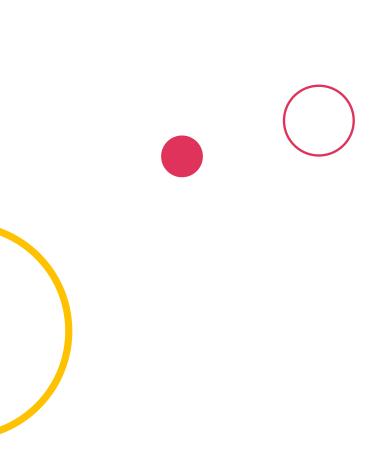

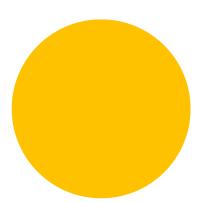
